

Brainstorm in a group.

Idea generating in a group by hitchhiking ideas.

Divide the participants into groups of 4 to 5 in a group. Seating should be in a circle.

Each participant will write down a problem they wish to solve. Be sure to add some context and details.

Step 1: Write out and explain your problem.

EXPLAIN your problem.

- Step 2: Everybody pass their problem sheet to the one on their left. Take the sheet from the person on your right.
- Step 3: Read the problem on the form in front of you. Take your time and think hard how you would solve it.

Step 4: Now fill in the next section with your idea on how you would solve the problem.

- Step 5: Again, everybody pass their sheet to the one on their left.
- Step 6: Read the problem on the sheet in front of you. See the idea that was added by the person before you. Take your time.
- Step 7: Now build on that idea that was already started and fill in the next section. Add features and elaborate.
- Step 8: Again, everybody pass their sheet to the one on their left.
- Step 9: Repeat until you finally get your own problem back.

See how your problem was solved by the members of the group.

This is called synthesis and will give you a new perspective and possibly lead you to a discovery of solving it.
